

Spancrete Project to Showcase in Parade of Homes

Spancrete Industries, Inc., Waukesha, Wisconsin, has collaborated with David & Goliath Builders, Inc., and Quality Concrete Products to complete the first concrete and masonry home to be featured in this year's Metropolitan Builders Association Parade of Homes event from August 16 through September 7, 2003.

The "Cobblestone Ranch" model is located at 2400 Brookside Drive in the Twin Creeks subdivision in the Town of Jackson, Wisconsin. This three-bedroom home has 2500 sq ft (230 m²) on the main level and 2000 additional sq ft (190 m²) in the lower level. While concrete block is used for all loadbearing walls, the exterior walls are covered with a combination of brick and stone. All floors are constructed of precast, prestressed Spancrete hollow-core slabs that clear-span the home's basement, creating a completely open, unobstructed lower level. David Rodrigues, president



of David & Goliath Builders, said, "We also built the garage floor with Spancrete hollow-core slabs because they create extra basement space below the garage."
